#### Finance:

 The budget 2024 review is now in progress. A preliminary budget should be ready by council's next meeting.

#### Museum:

 The museum is requesting approval of the annual distribution in the amount of \$7700.00 from the Eagles Mere Foundation for operating expenses. Kathy McCorkle made the motion for approval, second by Jim Way. All in favor. The Motion passed.

## Infrastructure:

- Dennis Craig made a motion to accept going ahead with the Clay Ave., Phase 3 project totaling \$47,800.00. A dirt and gravel grant will total \$37,000.00 to help with the cost of the project. Tom Graff second the motion. All approve and motion carried. It is in hopes that the Conservancy share the costs of the Clay Ave. project.
- The committee authorized Jay Wilkinson to look into a turnback program with the State for Laporte Ave. to the end of the Borough line.

### Ordinance:

 Dennis Craig made a motion to table and revisit the speed limit ordinance until we get more information from the state explaining their decision to not grant the 25mph speed limit change in the speed limit study. Motion second by Rick Leibert. All in favor, motion carried.

<u>Payment of Bills:</u> Approval of the reviewed outstanding vendor bills for the Borough moved by Mr. Craig and seconded by Mr. Graff. All in favor, the motion passed.
